A conference for land and countryside managers organised by the International Mountainbike Association in partnership with Forestry Commission (England).

Increased provision of mountainbike (mtb) trails by the Forestry Commission has led to as an yet unsatisfied demand for more mtb facilities closer to towns and cities, and a desire to make the current UK byway and bridleway network more suitable for use by cyclists.

Drawing heavily on case studies, this conference has been designed to inform land and countryside managers from both private and public sectors of best practice in the management of this rapidly growing recreation.

Delegates will also have the opportunity to attend a trailbuilding workshop on Saturday 30th September, and to take part in recreational mtb rides during the weekend.
